

COVID-19 Protection Concept

Swiss Water & Climate Forum 2021

9 & 10 September 2021

General

This protection concept (in accordance with the Covid-19 law and applicable Covid measures of the BAG) applies to the Swiss Water & Climate Forum 2021 and describes the measures for the protection of the participants. The aim of the measures is to protect all attendees from infection by the coronavirus and to prevent the spread of the virus.

Protective Measures

1. **Covid certificate:** Official proof (3G: vaccinated, recovered or tested) has to be shown upon entry combined with an official identification document (ID, Passport, etc.) in accordance with BAG requirements is required for participation. More information on the [BAG website](#).
2. **Masks:** It is recommended to wear masks at all times when indoors. During moments and in set-ups that do not allow for maintaining the distance of 1.5m between participants, masks are mandatory.
3. **Hygiene:** Disinfectant will be provided at the entrance to the indoor areas. Sufficient soap for regular hand washing in the restrooms is provided.
4. **Ventilation:** Closed rooms will be ventilated at regular intervals.
5. **Distance:** During the event, the specified minimum distance of 1.5 meters from all participants must be maintained. By preparing the table groups, the organizer ensures that this distance can be maintained. If this distance cannot be maintained temporarily, participants are encouraged to use protective masks.
6. **Contact details:** The swisswaterclimate association will store the contact details of all participants via participant registration for as long as specified by the BAG.
7. **Sick persons at the event:** Persons who show symptoms of a cold on the day before or on the days of the event itself are not allowed to participate in the event.
8. **Information of the persons present:** The participants will be informed by the organizer about the protection concept and about the applicable measures as well as the available hygiene articles.
